The teacher will remind students that the $a$ in cake is a long a and the e is silent. The teacher will remind students that silent letters are coded by crossing them out.

Teacher will remind students that when the sneaky e is in a word with u_e and o_e, the a makes the long vowel sound. Teacher will introduce Picture Card 34 . The word is hose. The teacher will remind students that the $\circ$ in hose is a long $\circ$ and the $e$ is silent. The teacher will also introduce Picture Card 35-cube. The teacher will remind students that silent letters are coded by crossing them out
